and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of November
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McGonkles presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term of from Five Years
to Life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray VanCott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elmer Clark Cole
I was convicted under the name of Charles Clark

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: O. R. Meacham

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as records show.
