Application of Charles Clark

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of November A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McKee presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 5 years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable R. A. Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elmer C. Cook I was convicted under the name of Charles Clark

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Orson Meacham

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
