Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4 day of Nov
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of
from 5 years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable R. A. Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elmer Clark Cole
I was convicted under the name of Charles Clark
