under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of April  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Richard L. Golding  
I was convicted under the name of Richard Golding

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except Receiving Stolen  
Property, and Grand Larceny.
