I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of petit larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of September
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve six months in the County Jail of
Salt Lake County, State of Utah,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the said Salt Lake County Jail, except for
the time I was in the County Hospital.

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rawlins, Attorney
Assistant District, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is FANNIE DAVIS

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except intoxication.
