Application of Harry Alexander

To the Honorable Board of Pardoners of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of November, A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate sentence of 1- to 20 yrs. with a recommendation of leniency and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable John D. Rice prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harry Noah Alexander I was convicted under the name of Harry Alexander.
