Application of Noel E. White No. 4444

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison (On Parole) under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Murder.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of September A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. McCrea presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Twenty Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
