Application of Tiburcio Gavica #4878

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of June, A. D. 1927, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in the First Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable LeRoy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Tiburcio Gavica
I was convicted under the name of Tiburcio Gavica

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
