and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court - Provo Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Turner presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 - to Ten Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison at Salt Lake City

Fourth-Honorable District Attorney Pahr prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harry Nelson

I was convicted under the name of Harry Nelson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Glude Blackburn, Elator Dunning

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Larceny
