Application of Harry Nelson No. 4823

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentences and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah state Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the Feb day of 17 A. D. 1927, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Provo Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Turner presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to The Utah state Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison at Salt Lake City

Fourth-Honorable District Attorney Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Harry Nelson I was convicted under the name of Harry Nelson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Claude Blackburn, Claten Dunning

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Larceny
