and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7 day of March  
A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge B. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One To Twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Christopher Smith  
I was convicted under the name of A. W. Hawkins

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Utah Industrial  
Training School Oct 3-1923-
