Application of Joe Z Marsh

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of August A. D. 1927, at Heber City County of Wasatch and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Martin M. Larsen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable N. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joe Z Marsh
I was convicted under the name of Joe Z Marsh

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
