Application of Arthur Jones No. 4948

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of January
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty (1-20)

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Arthur Jones
I was convicted under the name of Arthur Jones

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offenses
