First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixth day of June  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Hight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term from 1 to 20 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Wendell McMillen  
I was convicted under the name of Harry Miller

which I am now serving
