Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term of from one to twenty years. and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable A.E. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Warden H. McMillen I was convicted under the name of Harry Miller
