Application of Harry Miller No. 10466

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION to be reviewed to
Federal Authorities to stand trial on 1st Oct
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of October
A. D. 1935, at Richfield County of Sevier
and State of Utah, in 6th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. P. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 10 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable W. R. Nicholson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Burleigh

I was convicted under the name of Harry Miller

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
