First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with a deadly weapon

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Seventh day of March
A. D. 1927, at Bingham City County of Box Elder
and State of Utah, in first District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Melvin Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an ~~an~~ indeterminate sentence not to exceed
Five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Wm. Young prosecuted the case.
