First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Wife desertion

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of April
A. D. 1923, at Escalante County of Garfield
and State of Utah, in Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jos. E. Erickson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. J. Golding prosecuted the case.
