I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of October
A. D. 1925, at Price Utah County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Franklin Virgil Helms
I was convicted under the name of Frank Fitzgerald

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except
Salem Oregon for Burglary
