Application of Frank Fitzgerald

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in U. S. P. under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embezzlement

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for seven months

Fourth-- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.
