Application of Virgil Edson.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the seventh day of May A. D. 1924, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from ninety days to ten years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Virgil Edson, I was convicted under the name of Virgil Edson.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
