Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of Feb.
A. D. 1927, at Ogden Utah County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James M. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.
