I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8 day of October
A. D. 1923, at Tooele County of Tooele
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve from one to twenty
years in State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. B. Gordon prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Miles Berte
I was convicted under the name of Miles Berte

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John Perry - Released in
December 1923

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except This one
and if released will leave the State
