Hon. Sir;

I realize your time is valuable so I will be as brief as possible.

I am submitting my application, to the Hon. Board of Pardons, for a conditional termination. I was convicted on the 22nd day of March - 1924 on a charge of Forgery, of which I was guilty, and while in jail was taken seriously ill and for some time after coming to prison, was in the Hospital. I have enlargement of the heart caused by valvular leakage, for which there is no cure. I am also subject to inflammatory rheumatism. I have been told by the Doctors, that in proper surroundings and with proper treatment I would be able to do light work, but would never be sound physically and any possible shock, or excitement might be fatal.

My Sister and I were left by our Father, after the death of my Mother, to shift for ourselves. which was 21 years ago. My sister was later adopted by an uncle & found a good home. I was taken by my Grandparents and was again left 14 yrs.
