I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of December
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. M. McCre presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Fowler
I was convicted under the name of Thomas Fowler

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: E. R. Dixon + W. V. Dixon

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
