Application of Perry Boothe

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree Burglary

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of March
A. D. 1925, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,
paroled August 22nd 1926
