Application of Perry Boothe No. 5272

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of October, A. D. 1929, at Price, Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Fred V. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Perry Boothe I was convicted under the name of Same.
