Application of James Furukawa No. 4612

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault D. W. to do bodily harm

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of Oct. A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. S. Marks presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indt. term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Paroled Oct. 20, 1928.

Fourth-Honorable S. G. Clawson Asst. Dist. Atty. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Furukawa

I was convicted under the name of James Furukawa

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except June 4th. 1917 for Grand Larceny. Served from June 9, 1917 to May 1, 1919 in Utah State Prison.
