I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~in~~ on Parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with Deadly Weapon to do
Bodily Harm.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of December
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Williams
