Application of Frank Williams No. 4915

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of assault with a deadly weapon with intent to
do great bodily harm.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of October
A. D. 1927, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term not to exceed five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
