Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of September, A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. W. Mc Kenney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to From 5 to Life.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah S. Prison.

Fourth-Honorable C. W. Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank Williams.

I was convicted under the name of Frank Williams.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Assault.
