Application of Fred Shause # 4400

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in U. S. P. under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd deg.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of June A. D. 1924, at Morgan City, Utah County of Morgan and State of Utah, in 1st Judicial district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. P. Barber presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty yrs. with a recommendation for Clemency and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joe. Fredrick Shause I was convicted under the name of Fred Shause

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: C. F. Caldwell # 4401

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one I am now paying the penalty for.
