I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June  
A. D. 1924, at Morgan City County of Morgan  
and State of Utah, in 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on  
the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1924.
