Application of Lawrence C. Newberry.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, plea of guilty under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of October A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm M. Cree presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lawrence C. Newberry. I was convicted under the name of A. J. Clark.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 5 times in Colorado.
