A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. M. McCrear presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lawrence Clarence Newberry
I was convicted under the name of A. J. Clark

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 5th prior conviction
