First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of August  
A. D. 1925, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve from 6 months to three years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Attorney L. E. Evans prosecuted the case.
