First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2<sup>nd</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six months to Three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
