First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of December  
A. D. 1922, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in 2nd. District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term in the  
Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Robert Waller Henderson  
I was convicted under the name of R.W. Henderson
