Application of HOWARD CARTER

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of April, A. D. 1930, at Provo, County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. V. Watkins presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve a term of not less than one year nor more than twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Howard Carter I was convicted under the name of Howard Carter

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except a felony, to-wit: Forgery. Convicted September 19, 1925. Committed to State Prison October 5, 1925
