Application of Howard Carter.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon.  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison.  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th, day of September,  
A. D. 1925, at Provo, County of Utah,  
and State of Utah, in 4th. District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George B. Parker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term of One to Twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary.

Fourth-- Honorable N. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Howard Carter.  
I was convicted under the name of Howard Carter.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
