Application of Irven King

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of Sept.
A. D. 1923, at Nephi, Utah County of Garfield
and State of Utah, in 1st Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison for
6 mo. to 3 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable William Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Irven King
I was convicted under the name of Irven King

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
