First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of September
A. D. 1923, at Nephi County of Juab
and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge T. H. Burton presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to Six Months to three years in the
Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
