First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of May, A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Five Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Roy Fairbanks. I was convicted under the name of " "
