and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of May
A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in The Second Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Justice Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indefinite
 Term of One to Ten Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joe E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Roy Fairbanks
I was convicted under the name of Roy Fairbanks

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except The Present
