First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of September
A. D. 1923, at Duchesne City County of Duchesne
and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of imprisonment
and thereafter was imprisoned in the penitentiary of the State of Utah.

Fourth--Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Henry Moroni Chatwin,
I was convicted under the name of Moroni Chatwin.

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Andrew Defa.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except
I have never been convicted before.
