Gentlemen: We the under-signed, citizens of Duchesne County, Utah, living principally at Tabiona, Utah, respectfully petition your honorable body to grant the petition for parole of Moroni Chatwin of Tabiona, Utah, and respectfully represent as follows:

That we are well acquainted with Chaney C. Chatwin and Elizabeth Chatwin his wife, who are the parents of the said Moroni Chatwin now confined in the state penitentiary of Utah. That said parents have lived at Tabiona, Utah for about 13 years last past, and own a small farm of 40 acres on which they live, and make thier living principally by farming said land; that said parents are good people, and hard working, and that they have a large family consisting of eight children including said Moroni Chatwin. That said Moroni Chatwin has been a hard working boy, and was never in serious trouble before, so far as the under-signed know. That we believe it would be for the best good of said boy if he could be paroled and permitted to work with his father on the farm, and that the services of said boy would be of great help to his parents and in supporting the family. That we believe that the boy has been taught a lesson which will keep him out of further serious trouble, and that it would not be an act of injustice to the state or society, if said boy were paroled.

WHEREFOR we respectfully petition your honorable body to grant the application for parole, which we understand has been filed by or on behalf of said Moroni Chatwin. That we are familiar in general with the facts and circumstances under which the said Moroni
