Dear Sir:-

That Whereas on Niven Robinson, unmarried, aged eighteen years of age, a resident of Ogden City, Weber County, Utah, was on the 9th day of March 1925, sentenced by the District Court of Weber County, Utah, to serve a term of six months in the County Jail of Weber County, Utah, for the offense of having carnal knowledge of sexual intercourse with an unmarried female person,

And Whereas the said Niven Robinson is of immature years, and of a tender age, and has a mother in Ogden City, Utah, and with whom the said Niven Robinson resides,

Therefore we the undersigned residents of Weber County, Utah, believing that the ends of justice are now satisfied and that the said Niven Robinson by having been imprisoned in said Weber County Jail for a period of nearly two months, has atoned for the commission of said offense and that he desires to be given the opportunity to again re-establish himself as a law abiding citizen, hereby petition your Honorable Board for a pardon or parole for the said Niven Robinson.
