Application of W. J. Hoskin,

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with attempt to commit Rape,

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd June, day of 6th, A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd. Judicial District, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McCree, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Ten years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Wells Jenkins Hoskin, I was convicted under the name of W. J. Hoskin,
