I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of October
A. D. 1924, at Manti County of Sauete
and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dillworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.
