Application of Joseph Martin

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embezzlement

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd or 4th day of June  
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. A. Iverson presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate sent-  
-ence of from one to ten (1-10) yrs.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth--Honorable Edgar A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Joseph Martin  
I was convicted under the name of " "

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None - pleaded guilty but en-  
deavored to make restitution.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except -- Arrested for  
speeding + other minor traffic violations at  
Los Angeles and was given fines, also  
arrested at Ogden, Utah, case dismissed.  
Arrested at Salt Lake Dec 28th 1923  
for Embezzlement for which I am now serving.

Prison No. 4388  
Recommendation, Five years.  
Previous record, Ogden, Utah.
